

**2021 WHAM Basketball Season**  
**Additional District Rules/Regulations for us to Follow While Using Gilbert/Higley Properties**

**Practice Sites**

- It is recommended to ask parents to drop off or wait in the car in the parking lot until practices are over. Bleachers/benches will not be available for use during our practice time.
- If a parent/guardian has chosen to stay, only one parent/guardian allowed per child in the gym at any point in time. No siblings allowed at any point.
- No wondering around campus.
- Mask must be worn when entering and exiting the building and are to remain on when physically distancing is not able to be followed.
  - If practicing on the court or doing activity that is not reasonable or feasible to wear the mask, they are not required to do so.
  - If 6-foot physical distancing can be followed, masks do not have to be worn during activity.
- Other standard rules as follows such as if you feel sick, stay home. Clean equipment you bring in prior to arriving in the building. Encourage proper hygiene, hand washing and sanitizing.
- If anyone should test positive for COVID-19, you must inform Doug Forsgren/Shana Blixt with WHAM Basketball so we can communicate to the District.

**Game Sites**

- No more than 25% capacity in any given gym. This will allow for 2 teams, 2 coaches per team, 1 parent/guardian per player and a scorekeeper for each team.
- Mask must be worn when entering and exiting the building and are to remain on when physically distancing is not able to be followed.
  - If playing on the court or doing activity that is not reasonable or feasible to wear the mask, they are not required to do so.
  - If 6-foot physical distancing can be followed, masks do not have to be worn during activity.
- It is required that we sanitize between each game. WHAM will supply the materials and have been asked to assign a parent/guardian from each team to wipe down benches after use (only those that have been sat on).
- Only those teams assigned to play are allowed in the gym. The next group will need to wait outside until the referee or staff member acknowledge for you to come in. Time is of the essence so each game will be approximately 50 minutes which will allow 10 minutes to clean before the next group comes in. Custodial staff will take care of all other cleaning, i.e., bathrooms, floors, etc.
- Any snacks and/or discussions will need to take place immediately outside in order for the next teams to come into the gym for their scheduled games.

Please note that things are changing all the time. This is where we are at now, but tomorrow a school could get closed for 14 days and no one would be allowed to enter the school. We must follow District guidelines or we could be shut down. Any questions, concerns or issues, please contact either myself or Doug Forsgren.
